MANUFACTURING: In 2025, Missouri produced more than 674,000 vehicles at its Ford and GM plants, including every Chevrolet Colorado, GMC Canyon, Chevrolet Express, and GMC Savana on the market. Missouri is also the production hub for many of the Ford Transit vans and more than 265,000 Ford F-150s.

ACCELERATING PROGRESS THROUGH RESEARCH CENTERS:

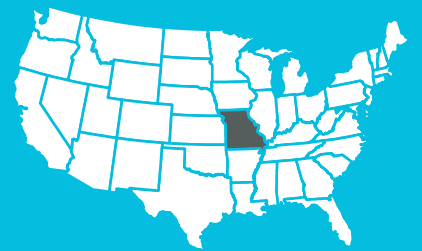
Research centers across the state are driving advancements in energy storage, sustainable materials, and advanced engineering.
