WORLD-CLASS TALENT: Missouri's tech industry employs more than 157,000 workers. Training programs like LaunchCode and Claim Academy continue to cultivate a tech talent pool that rivals any state in the U.S.

A BOOMING TECH ECOSYSTEM: Innovation communities across the state are pushing the envelope with new and exciting ideas at places such as the Global Center for Cybersecurity @ Cortex, The Missouri Cybersecurity Center of Excellence, and the National Center of Excellence in Information Assurance Education at the Missouri University of Science & Technology.

SUPPORTIVE INFRASTRUCTURE: From extensive fiber networks providing gigabit service to dedicated resources for expanding high speed internet to unserved areas of the state, Missouri is growing economic opportunity through investments in broadband infrastructure.

LOW BUSINESS COSTS: Missouri ranks 6th in the nation for lowest cost of doing business, earning the state an A grade from CNBC. Missouri also ranks 4th for best corporate income tax index and 5th for best unemployment insurance tax index (Tax Foundation).

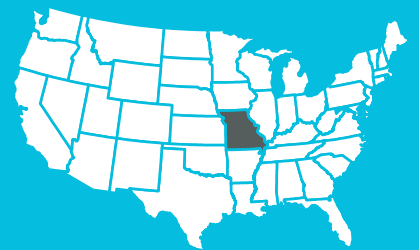
