

HOME TO ESSENTIAL RESOURCES: Missouri is one of the leading producers of lead for batteries in the U.S. and is home to what is likely the largest cobalt reserve in North America. Missouri is also making strides in lithium production, helping to meet the rising demand for this critical resource.

TALENT THAT POWERS INNOVATION: Innovation and collaboration is happening statewide at places such as the Battery Analytical Investigation Group at Washington University in St. Louis, the Multiphysics Energy Research Center at the University of Missouri in Columbia, and the Missouri Center for Advanced Power System at Missouri Southern State University in Joplin.
