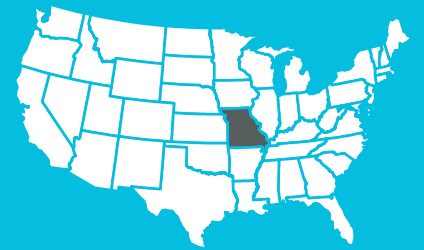

HIGHLY SKILLED: Missouri's healthcare industry employs 407,500 highly skilled individuals within more than 58,900 companies.

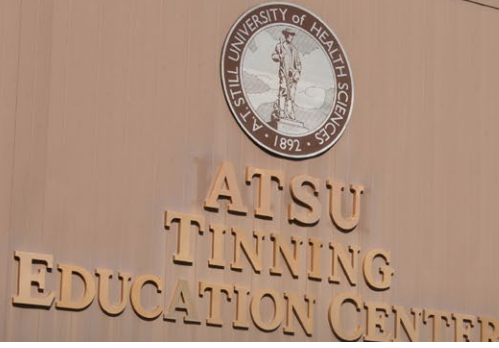
INVESTING IN HEALTH: Missouri is committed to investing in health innovation with both private and public funds being invested in this growing sector.
