

MISSOURI'S DATA CENTERS INDUSTRY

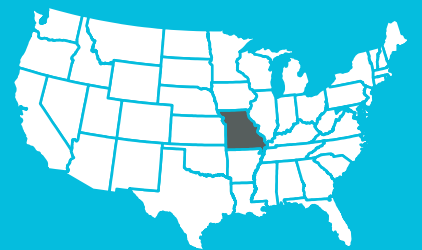
LOW BUSINESS COSTS: Missouri's cost-competitive business environment makes our state an attractive location for data centers. In Missouri, you will pay less for energy and talent.

A GROWING INDUSTRY: Missouri data centers benefit from the presence of a strong cluster of technology firms, fiber, suppliers, and educators throughout the state.

SKILLED WORKFORCE: In Missouri, our tech industry employs 161,200 of our private sector workers, and that talent pool is growing. Training programs like LaunchCode and Claim Academy are delivering tech talent at an accelerated rate for Missouri employers.

GREEN POWER: Missouri utilities plan to add more than 3,700 MW of wind and 5,000 MW of solar power over the next 10 years.

SMART INCENTIVES: Data centers may be eligible to receive exemptions from sales taxes on utilities, machinery, equipment, computers, and construction materials for a new or expanded facility for up to 10-15 years.

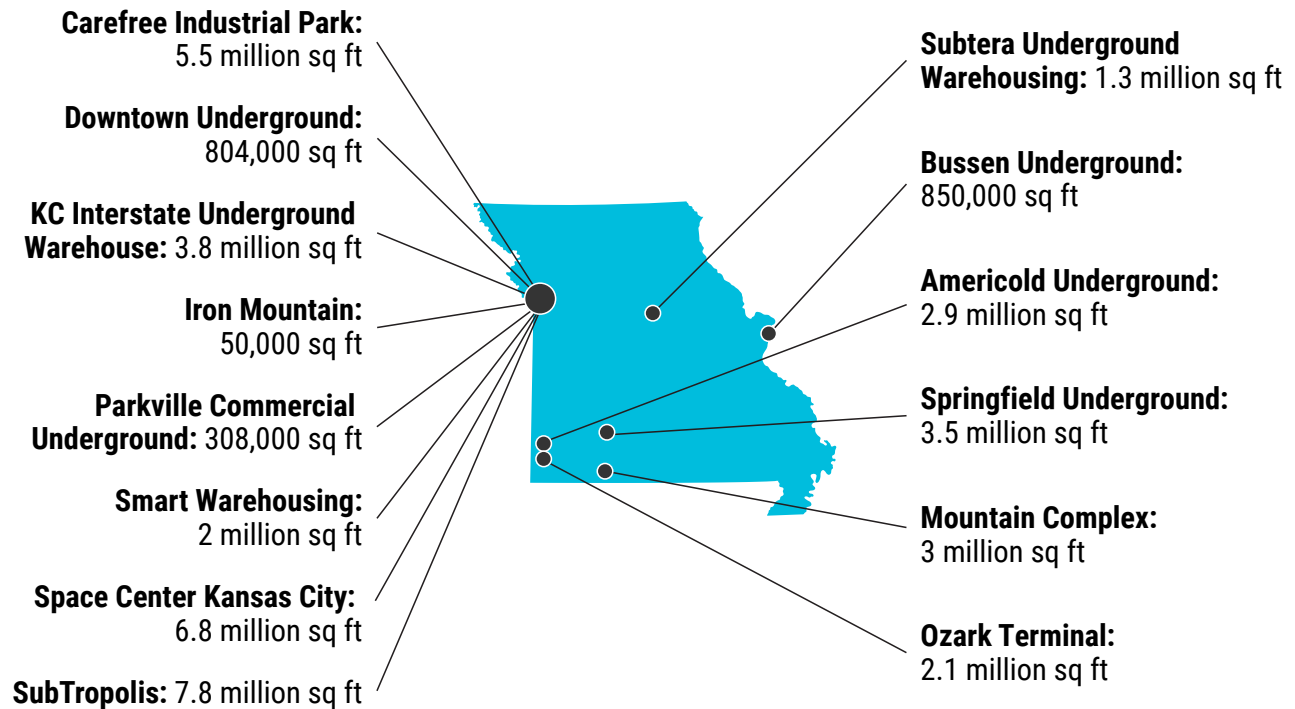
